The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) has scheduled a public involvement meeting to discuss the upcoming improvements of WIS 50 in Delavan, Wisconsin. The meeting will be held on:

Delavan, Wisconsin**

The purpose of the meeting is to provide information on the layout of the proposed roadway and discuss traffic impacts during construction. The meeting will follow an informal, open house format. Short presentations will be given at 5:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. discussing the proposed project staging. WisDOT representatives will be available to discuss the proposed project and address any questions or concerns.

The proposed project consists of three segments. The first segment is from Wisconsin Street to Park Avenue and will consist of pavement resurfacing and water main replacement. The second segment starts at Park Avenue and ends approximately 500 feet east of Wright Street and will include street widening and a reconfigured signalized intersection. The last segment consists of a new multi-use path along the north side of WIS 50 that will connect existing facilities at Wright Street to the commercial district east of I-43. Bicycle and pedestrian accommodations will be incorporated into the newly reconstructed areas.

Right of way acquisition has been completed for the project. Impacts and modifications to some existing driveways along the project are also expected but access will be maintained. Construction is scheduled for 2017.
