Delavan Special Use Facilities

21. Rudy Lange Sledding Hill - Winter recreation area located at the corner of Washington and Terrace Streets. The hill is lighted throughout the winter months and provides a 335’ sledding run with a 33% slope at its north end. Please use caution at the top of the hill to avoid automobile traffic.

22. Swan Creek Recreational Trail – Following along Swan Creek, this crushed gravel pedestrian and bike path connects Veteran’s Park, Terrace Park, Rudy Lange Sledding Hill and Springs Park. The winding trail provides various benches/rest areas, restroom facilities and is complete with periodic signs and maps to guide trail users.

23. Ben Dibble Nature Trail - Dedicated to the City of Delavan in 1962 as a natural plant and wildlife area, this trail begins at the northeast corner of Paul Lange Arboretum. The winding wood chip trail runs through the Ora Rice Arboretum and along the Lake Comus shoreline.

24. Comus Lake – A 114 acre lake on Delavan’s North side, the lake offers opportunities for fishing, canoeing and boating. Bordered on the North side by the Paul Lange Arboretum, the lake offers visitors a multitude of beautiful scenic vistas. A great place to go for a paddle or walk the adjacent trails.

25. Andy’s Park – This bike / skateboard / roller blade facility is located within Veteran’s Memorial Park and includes special features such as: 4’ quarter pipe, 12’ wide; 9’ wall ride, 12’ wide; 5’ mini-half pipe, 24’ wide with extensions and roll-in; and more.

26. Mill Pond / Recreation Building – This swimming facility includes the Mill Pond Recreation Building, swimming pond, beach, beach play equipment, sand volleyball court and picnic areas. The facility is located within Veteran’s Memorial Park.
